Australia has one of the highest levels of Methamphetamine use per capita in the world. This has seen a sharp rise in the number of properties contaminated from the manufacture and/or usage of Methamphetamine. This has become a major issue for property owners and PCBUs, who have a duty of care obligation to provide a safe environment for occupants.

The residual contaminants which arise from a drug manufacture or "cooking" process can be in the form of solids, liquids or vapours and be absorbed by floorings, walls, drains, ducting and any furnishings or fixtures in the vicinity of the clan lab. These contaminants can in many instances persist within structures, furnishing and the environment and pose a risk to persons occupying the premises, potentially for many years into the future. There is clear evidence showing that many of the residual chemical contaminants produced during the drug manufacture process are of a hazardous nature and include heavy metals, carcinogens and phytotoxic substances.
